Controllability of Lighting

Studies have shown that providing lighting controls and different light levels will improve occupant comfort and productivity, not to mention save on energy needs. For this reason LEED v4 has developed an entire credit dedicated to interior lighting. The principles outlined can be applied to any project, and while currently are only a part of LEED, they will certainly be part of future building code requirements.
